

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION - JUNE 11, 2024 – PERSHING COUNTY, NEVADA

Pursuant to NRS 293.203, I, Lacey Donaldson, Pershing County Clerk-Treasurer, hereby give notice that the Pershing County Primary Election will be held on June 11, 2024.

The Primary Election will be a hybrid election. All active registered voters in Pershing County will be sent a mail ballot. If you wish to vote in-person you must appear at the polling location identified below during polling location hours.

Nevada conducts closed primary elections. Voters may only vote in a major party race if affiliated with that party. Please confirm your voter registration is current so the mail ballot will be sent to the correct address and you will receive the correct ballot style based on your party affiliation, if any.

April 12, 2024:	Deadline for Clerk’s Office to receive mail ballot opt-out form, if you do not wish to receive a mail ballot.
May 14, 2024:	Standard close of postmarked mail or in-person voter registration.
May 14 – May 28, 2024	Extended online voter registration or voter registration updates.
May 29 – June 11, 2024	Online registrants must appear at the polling location during Early Voting or on Election Day to provide a valid Nevada Drivers License or Nevada Identification Card and proof of residency.
